ASSINGTON CORONATION CELEBRATION MEMORIES

During the high tea I asked the attendees where they were at the time of the last coronation and received some great feedback from them as follows:

Lily remembered having a street party;

Jean Evans, watched the ceremony with 16 other kids on a 9 inch TV;

Ann Warner went to London by train the night before with her father and saw Her Majesty pass on her way back to the palace at Hyde Park Corner;

Jean Hogger was living in Great Sampford and had a family get together and watched all the ceremony on a 9 inch TV;

Jean Benton was in the house next to the old post office in Assington where Simon White lives and Mrs Tatiss let the village kids watch the ceremony on a small 9 inch TV in her front room;

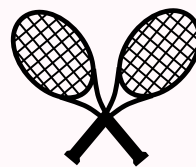

PARISH CHURCH NEWS



*Letter from the
Rev Simon White
Associate Priest,
Bures with Assington and
Little Cornard*



Dear Friends,

As someone who spends their working life in front of a computer, in a largely windowless office, I don't stop to look around and marvel at the countryside as much as I could.

During the pandemic our office in Colchester was severely de-cluttered to help us keep it sterile but that left it bland. A couple of events, that I won't go into, left morale a little low, prompting us to look for ways to help cheer things up in a place where we spend a lot of time with people who have become friends as well as work colleagues. It was suggested we should bring in some plants to help us all better connect with nature, the idea being to "bring the outside in", ever aware that some are happy to leave the outside...outside. So, to make the office a little greener various plants were bought to see what would thrive given little daylight and only sporadic care. Some have flourished while others are clearly unhappy. One plant brought with it a small swarm of bugs that then flew around the office until it was banished. I am glad to report that "re-greening" our office has been a success and has done its little bit to improve the mental health of all who work there.

We are fortunate to be surrounded by countryside with our churchyard's local treasures. Many churchyards are surviving fragments of meadow that serve as island refuges for plants and wildlife, as well as the wide variety of mosses and lichens which can be found on old stonework. They are often the most ancient enclosed piece of land in our parishes, with grassland that has re-seeded naturally for hundreds, if not thousands, of years. Never having been ploughed or treated with fertilizer or herbicides our churchyards can act as Noah's arcs for flora and fauna that can then spread further afield from these havens.

A local farmer once told me that he wasn't very impressed with God because he thought that farmers and scientists had done a much better job developing better varieties of crops that grew more quickly and were more resistant to disease. It was one of those moments when I was completely stumped as to what to say next until I remembered that St Paul had answered the question when he wrote to the Corinthians saying, "I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the growth." He later wrote, "For we are God's servants, working together; you are God's field, God's building"

We are called to be stewards of all we see and, for many, we get a glimpse of God in the beauty that surrounds us.

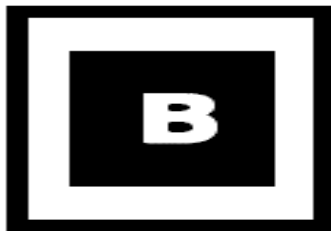

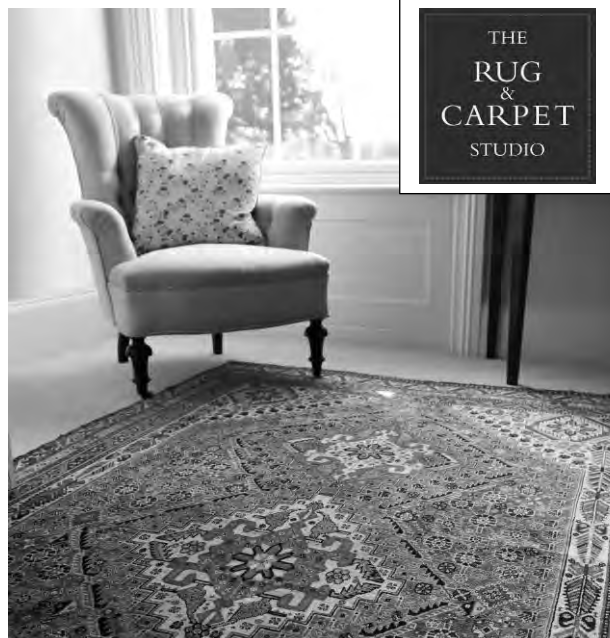
